profession, on a professional level. That's probably what you want to do too, I would think, from the moment you bought or received this book as a gift. What you need to understand, right from the start, is that the audience in the room is different. There are many ways to characterize it but I think if you pick these three categories that I present in my public speaking books it will be much easier for you to calibrate to the audience and control the room. Understand that the audience will have three attitudes towards you, these attitudes overlap the three groups you have in the room. The audience judges you and evaluates you according to their own criteria. Why is public speaking vital?
