*Surplus-Enjoyment* Mar 25 2022 Contemporary life is defined by excess. There must always be more, there is never enough. We need a surplus to what we need to be able to truly enjoy what we have. The longitudinal analysis in this book shows that spin-outs could hinder the subsequent development of existing technology when that technology is

still at a nascent level, because the cumulative effects of technological development could disappear if research and development personnel leave their parent firms in order to target different sub-markets. The findings of this book show that institutional settings designed to promote spin-outs do not necessarily promote innovation. The book offers novel theoretical insights into the relationship between institutions promoting spin-outs and the developments of general purpose technology.

*Production Organizations in Japanese Economic Development* Jan 23 2022 In this important new book, the authors explore how production was organized in the context of the economic development of modern Japan.
