emotions in organizations; leadership and health care; creativity at work; business and the environment; and bias in performance appraisals. Ultimately, academic scholars in management and allied fields (e.g., sociology of organizations and organizational psychology) will see *The Academy of Management Annals* as a valuable resource to turn to for comprehensive, up-to-date information-- published in a single volume every year by the preeminent association for management research.
